

On some Mustelinae from the Pliocene bone breccia of Węże

This paper describes the remains of skulls and mandibles of three species, namely *Mustela pliocaenica* n. sp., *Mustela plioerminea* n. sp. and *Martes wenzensis* n. sp. By their characteristic features all the three described species come very near to their Pleistocene representatives as well as to the living forms.
