

Blue-green algae from the Tremadocian of the Holy Cross Mountains (Poland)

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Schizothrichites ordoviciensis n. gen., n. sp., a Tremadocian blue-green alga, with exceptionally well preserved microscopical structure is described. It was etched from the chalcedony of the Holy Cross Mountains. Its close similarity to recent genus *Schizothrix* (Cyanophyceae) is shown.

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
