

Middle Lias miliolids from western Pomerania Poland

Six species of *Ophthalmidium* and *Cornuloculina*, including 3 new ones (*C. plana* sp.n., *C. polonka* sp.n., and *C. pazdroe* sp.n.) are described from the Middle Lias of NW Poland. The species were differentiated taking into account biometric data: length and width of test, length-to-width ratio, length and number of chambers, and size of proloculus. *Ophthalmidium concentricum* (Terquem and Berthelin) is considered to be more shallow-water in requirements than *Cornuloculina orbiculare* (Burbach).
