



## *Zofiaprion* nom. nov., replacement name for *Leptoprion* Kielan-Jaworowska, 1966 (Annelida: Polychaeta)

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The genus-group name *Leptoprion* Kielan-Jaworowska, 1966, has been found to be pre-occupied. The name *Zofiaprion* nom. nov. is proposed as a replacement.

Krekich-Strassoldo (1914) gave the name *Leptoprion* to a genus of Recent ant-like beetles (Coleoptera: Anthicidae), containing the single new species *Leptoprion angulatus*. Only one female specimen of *L. angulatus*, collected in Sumatra, is known: the possible affinities of the genus are discussed by Kejval (2013).

Kielan-Jaworowska (1966) gave the name *Leptoprion* to an extinct genus of polychaete worms with the two species *Leptoprion polonicus* (type) and *Leptoprion artus*, described from jaw apparatus found in erratic boulders of Northern (presumably Scandinavian or Estonian) origin collected in central Poland, and placed in her newly described family Kalloprionidae. Männil and Zaslavskaja (1985) added a third species, *Leptoprion rectangularis*, from the Silurian of northern Siberia.

The name *Leptoprion* Kielan-Jaworowska, 1966 is therefore a junior homonym of *Leptoprion* Krekich-Strassoldo, 1914, and must be replaced in accordance with ICZN Article 60. It has no known available synonyms. The replacement name *Zofiaprion* nom. nov. (gender masculine: ZooBank registration urn:lsid:zoobank.org:act:17D59A81-32F3-4DAD-915A-310CEE216C42) is hereby proposed, combining the name of the author Zofia Kielan-Jaworowska with the element *-prion* (from Greek πρίων, saw).
