

A tapir tooth from Nowa Wieś Królewska near Opole (Poland)

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A tapir lower premolar (P2), collected from the Miocene (Sarmatian) of Nowa Wieś Królewska near Opole, is described. Its identification as *Tapirus* cf. *telleri* Hofmann may be also based on similarities displayed by the mammalian assemblage from Opole to that from Göriach which yielded remains of *Tapirus telleri* Hofmann.

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
